FAMILY LIFE - LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS

The last part of March and beginning of April presented itself in a new way for our family. First and foremost, Charlotte had surgery to remove an enlarged parathyroid gland, and she is healing very well. Thanks to everyone for holding her up in your prayers, as they were felt and greatly appreciated. Secondly, Hal spent the last week of March in Miami, Florida shooting and recording HomeBuilder training for 20 couples from the Miami area and Latin America. What was interesting is that most of it was done in Spanish or English with a translator at FamilyLife. God sustained us through fairly long days, from 6:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. or later each night. From everything that happened during the week, we were amazed at the excitement these couples had for reaching the people in their culture for Christ. One of the men was even the head of the Baptist Convention for part of Latin America and has already implemented FamilyLife materials as the 'materials of choice' for marriage and family for all of the convention. I really enjoyed all of the passion these couples presented in their desire to hurry back to their homes and get started. Also, these people came to this training on their own dime, costing about \$3,000 to \$4,000 per couple with all of their expenses, and they took vacation time to attend. It re-inspired us to be even more diligent about the task we have at FamilyLife behind the scenes. The videos will now help others receive the training via the web without the large expense of travel. With your faithful prayer and support, Latin America has leaders trained to minister to marriages and families. Thanks, again, to all of you who make it possible for us to serve in God's ministry.
