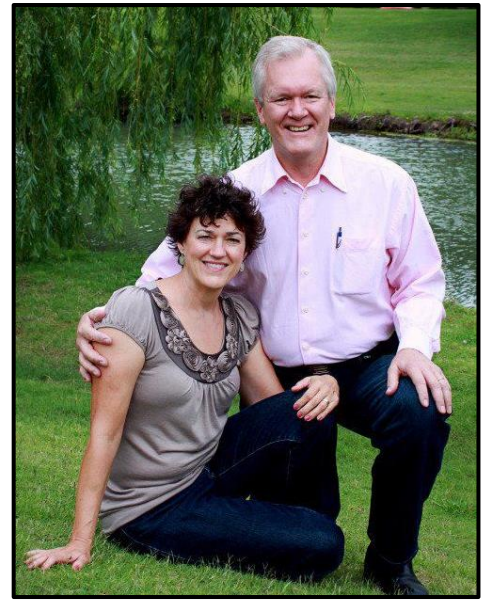

John also served as the pastor of an English-speaking church in Guatemala.

John and Gail moved back to Tulsa several years ago. John continues to work remotely with SETECA. John also serves on the pastoral staff of Southern Hills Baptist Church, working in their Hispanic ministry in the areas of discipleship, mobilization, and teaching. He is also mentoring two Hispanic couples who are planning on going into foreign missions. Gail works as a special education teacher in Tulsa Public Schools, utilizing her Spanish language skills with her students. She is also involved with her school's Good News Club.
