God's love for us...

- 1. Initiates the Gospel - John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.
- 2. Keeps us - Deuteronomy 7:9** Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations...
- 3. Is merciful and gracious - Psalm 86:15** But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.
- 4. Extends to sinners - Romans 5:8** But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- 5. Gives life to the dead - Ephesians 2:4-5** But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made alive together with Christ – by grace you have been saved –
- 6. Makes us children of God - I John 3:1a** See what kind of love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are.
- 7. Means we can abide in Him - I John 4:16** So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.
- 8. Was manifested in Christ - I John 4:9** In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so we might live through him.
- 9. Was demonstrated by Christ - John 15:9** As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you. Abide in my love.
- 10. Shows us how to love - John 15:13** Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.
- 11. Delivers us from judgement - I John 4:18** There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.

Our love for God...

- 12. Becomes part of our life - Proverbs 3:3** Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart.
- 13. Influences everything - 1 Corinthians 16:14** - Let all that you do be done in love.

- 14. Sanctifies us - Romans 12:9** Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good.
- 15. Should occupy our entire being - Mark 12:30** 'And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.'
- 16. Flows out to those around us - I Thessalonians 3:12** ...and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you...

Our love for others...

- 17. Produces harmony - Colossians 3:14** - And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.
- 18. Covers up offense - Proverbs 10:12** Hatred stirs up strife, but love covers all offenses.
- 19. Is the right response to His love - I John 4:11** Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.
- 20. Is the lawful thing to do - Romans 13:8** Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.
- 21. Should be our eager, but patient, pursuit - Ephesians 4:2, 3** ...with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- 22. Holds in good times or bad - Proverbs 17:17** A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.
- 23. Affirms our salvation - I John 4:7** Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.
- 24. Is our highest priority - 1 Peter 4:8** - Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.
- 25. Includes even our enemies - Luke 6:27** But I say to you who hear, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you...
- 26. Is commanded by our Savior - John 15:12** This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.
- 27. Is proven by action - I John 3:18** Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.
- 28. Is the most important thing we can do - 1 Corinthians 13:13** - So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.
