C spent much of her childhood at TBC. She learned of her missions organization in college and has been overseas since 2017, serving among the "Karis" people in a Muslim-majority country.

C has several focuses of ministry. One focus is building friendships with young women and sharing the good news of Jesus with them - not an easy task in a country whose young people are generally indifferent to spiritual topics! Another focus is serving alongside her team members in the ministry of a local house church, encouraging and supporting Karis believers. A third focus is working as an English teacher, teaching nationals as well as refugees. A



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fourth focus is continued language acquisition, building fluency, vocabulary, and ease of expression in order to share spiritual and biblical truths in a more natural way.

C has had many important spiritual conversations with her Muslim friends over her almost decade of service. She hopes and works toward a future where many more will agree to read the Bible with her and experience true forgiveness and joy for themselves.
