Cliff Truman left for the mission field in Chile in 1961; he has been a TBC missionary for over 60 years! Cliff grew up in a nominal Christian home in Colorado, eventually coming to faith in high school, attending a Christian college in Washington, and hearing the call to missions. While serving in a church in college, Cliff met and married his wife, Cathy. After training at Dallas Theological Seminary, Cliff, Cathy, and their family moved to South America. Cliff ministered in teaching national leaders at the two GMSA Bible Institutes in Chile as well as in church planting for a few years in Argentina. Cathy served as mother, homemaker, office help for their Bible correspondence ministry, preparer of Bible studies, and artist.

When Cliff and Cathy hit their organization's *required* retirement age of 70, they moved to a retirement village in Florida. Cathy passed away in 2022. Every month Cliff has sent email reports of people he is meeting and witnessing to in his nursing home.
