<b>Opportunities and wisdom to share the Gospel with unbelievers</b>		
1	Col 4.5	5 Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. <b>Day of fasting and prayer from 7A-Noon.</b>
2	Eph 6.19-20	19 and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.
3	2 Thess 3.1	Finally, brothers, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may speed ahead and be honored...
4	2 Cor 2.14	14 But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.
5	1 Cor 2.2	2 For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.
6	James 1.5	5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.
7	Col 4.6	6 Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.
<b>Thanks for the right, responsibility, and grace to represent Christ</b>		
8	Romans 1.16	For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
9	2 Cor 5.20	Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.
10	Acts 20.24	24 But I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.
11	Rom 10.15	And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!”
12	Phil 1.3-5	3 I thank my God in all my remembrance of you... 5 because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now.
13	Col 1.10	10 so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;
14	Phil 1.27	27 Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel,

<b>Courage to proclaim the Gospel faithfully, wisely, gently, and truthfully</b>		
15	Col 4.3-4	3 At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison— 4 that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.
16	1 Peter 3.15	15 but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect,
17	Psa 105.1	1 Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples.
18	Col 1.28	28 Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ.
19	2 Tim 4.5	5 As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.
20	2 Tim 1.7	7 for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.
21	Psa 67.2	2 that your way may be known on earth, your saving power among all nations

22	Matthew 5.13	13 You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet.
23	Matthew 5.16	16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.
24	Acts 13.47	47 For so the Lord has commanded us, saying, "I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth."
25	1 Cor 9.22	22 To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some.
26	John 15.8	8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.
27	Col 1.27	27 To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles the glorious riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
28	1 John 4.7	7 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.
29	Acts 1.8	8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
30	Eph 4.1	I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called...
