

**July 2024 Tulsa Bible Church Prayer Calendar**  
**Praying Through Galatians**

*You are invited to fast and pray for our church on July 1. (Schedule time as you are able)*

**1 Galatians 1:3-5** Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen. *Pray that we will thank God daily that our Savior delivered us from the present evil age according to the will of God our Father.*

**2 Galatians 1:10** For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ. *Pray that as individuals and as a congregation we would seek the approval of God instead of trying to please man.*

**3 Galatians 1:23-24** They only were hearing it said, "He who used to persecute us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy." And they glorified God because of me. *Pray that other people would glorify God because of the people of TBC.*

**4 Galatians 2:20a** I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. *Pray we would worship Christ who was crucified, rose again, and lives in us.*

**5 Galatians 2:20b** And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. *Pray that we would live each day by faith in the Son of God who loved us and gave himself for us.*

**6 Galatians 3:3b** Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh? *Pray that each of us would remember that we are being perfected by the Spirit of God and not by our works.*

**7 Galatians 3:26-27** for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. *Pray that we would praise God that we are sons and daughters of God through faith and have put on Christ and that we would live in that truth.*

**8 Galatians 3:28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. *Pray we would love each other as brothers and sisters in Christ, welcome our differences, and enjoy our unity in Christ Jesus.*

**9 Galatians 4:6** And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" *Praise God that because we are his adopted children, He has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts crying, "Abba! Father!"*

**10 Galatians 5:1** For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. *Pray we would each live in the freedom of God's grace and not submit to the yoke of legalism and/or self-righteousness.*

**11 Galatians 5:6** For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love. *Pray that we would be a people who give evidence of "faith working through love" in our relationship with God, with each other, and with the other people he brings into our lives.*

**12 Galatians 5:13.** For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. *Pray that we will serve one another through love.*

**13 Galatians 5:14** For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." *Pray our congregation would make Jesus known and be known as people who love their neighbors.*

**14 Galatians 5:16** But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. *Pray that each of us would desire God, walk by the Spirit, and have strength to resist the temptations of the flesh.*

**15 Galatians 5:17** For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. *Pray for discernment to see, to understand and to win the battle of the Spirit and flesh going on in our lives.*

**16 Galatians 5:19-21a**

Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. *Pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal to each of us any works of the flesh that our hearts are yielding to.*

**17 Galatians 5:22-23** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. *Pray that we, individually and collectively, would bear the fruit of the Spirit in our lives.*

**18 Galatians 5:25** If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit. *Pray that each of us would keep in step with the Spirit.*

**19 Galatians 5:26** Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. *Pray that the Spirit will convict us if we fall into these harmful and hurtful attitudes toward one another and that we would repent and ask His forgiveness.*

**20 Galatians 6:1a** Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. *Pray in gentleness we would restore our brothers and sisters who have sinned.*

**21 Galatians 6:1b** Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. *Pray that we will each keep careful watch for temptations that come to us.*

**22 Galatians 6:2** Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. *Pray that we would be faithful to help each other carry our burdens.*

**23 Galatians 6:3** For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. *Pray that we would accept with humility God's view of us and not be deceived by our own view of ourselves.*

**24 Galatians 6:6** Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches. *Pray we would be generous toward our teachers and leaders.*

**25 Galatians 6:7-8** Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

*Pray that we would not be deceived, but that we will "sow to the Spirit."*

**26 Galatians 6:9** And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. *Pray for God to give each of us individually and as the family of God strength we need to faithfully do the good God has for us to do.*

**27 Galatians 6:10** So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith. *Pray we will see and act on the opportunities God gives us to do good to everyone He brings into our lives, especially to our brothers and sisters at TBC.*

**28 Galatians 6:14** But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

*Pray that we would boast only in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ and not in ourselves.*

**29 Galatians 6:14** But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

*Praise God that the world has been crucified to me and that I have been crucified to the world.*

**30 Galatians 6:15** For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. *Praise God that we are new creations in Christ and pray we would encourage each other in that truth.*

**31 Galatians 6:16** And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. *Pray that we would be a people who walk by this rule and abide in God's peace and mercy.*
