Position: Family Ministry Pastor

Summary: The family pastor's primary responsibility is to carry out TBC's vision by providing spiritual and organizational leadership to junior and senior high students as well as men's and women's ministries. Key priorities include: recruit and train leadership team, oversee weekly ministry gatherings, lead student events and retreats, provide personal involvement in student life outside church gatherings, and oversee the family ministries budget with strategic growth initiatives and creativity. Secondary responsibilities include leading TBC's social media platforms and assisting the senior pastor in pastoral care. Measurements of success: reaching new students, salvations, baptisms, and student leadership program.

TBC has a renewed vision to reach the growing population of Tulsa, especially younger families through relevant, Gospel-driven teaching and discipleship, family-oriented events, community involvement, and social media engagement.

Responsibilities Related to Family Ministry

- Direct student ministry (grades 7-12) with specific strategies for reaching new students, yearly events, engaging web-page, weekly worship and retreats
- Lead team of parents/volunteers by equipping for effective student discipleship
- Create and sustain student leadership program
- Work alongside children's director and college ministry for life-stage transitions
- Lead all family ministry areas/leaders and strategically oversee resources to achieve vision.

Responsibilities Related to Social Media and Pastoral Assistance

- Lead and monitor TBC social media platforms through policy and social media team
- Assist senior pastor with services and shepherding needs to care for the church
