**Virtues to Pray for Yourself, Your Children, and Each Other**  
**January 2023**

*As each one is able, please join in prayer and fasting on January 1st, from 7 AM to noon.*

1. **Salvation.** [Father, grant that our children] ...may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. (2 Timothy 2:10)
2. **Grace.** [May our children] grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 3:18)
3. **Love.** [Grant, Lord, for us to] keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. (1 Peter 4:8)
4. **Honesty and integrity.** May integrity and uprightness preserve me, for I wait for you. (Psalm 25:21)
5. **Watchfulness.** So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober. (1 Thessalonians 5:6)
6. **Love for God's word.** [Make us to love your words, for] More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. (Psalm 19:10)
7. **Righteousness, justice, and equity.** [Grant us to be attentive to your wisdom, for we] Then...will understand righteousness and justice and equity, every good path; (Proverbs 2:9)
8. **Mercy.** [Lord, may we] Be merciful, even as [our] Father is merciful. (Luke 6:36)
9. **Respect.** [Father, as your word commands, grant that we show proper respect and] Honor everyone. (1 Peter 2:17a)
10. **Biblical self-esteem.** [Father, help us recognize that] ...we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)
11. **Love and faithfulness.** Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart. (Proverbs 3:3)
12. **Courage.** [Make us] ...strong and courageous...for it is the LORD your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you. (Deuteronomy 31:6)
13. **Purity.** Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. (Psalm 51:10)
14. **Kindness and forgiveness.** [Teach us to] Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you. (Ephesians 4:32)
15. **Generosity.** [God, enable our children] ...to be generous and ready to share, thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life. (1 Timothy 6:18-19)
16. **Peacemaking.** [Lord give us grace to be] ...peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. (Matthew 5:9)

17. **Joy.** [Lord, when afflicted, may I have] ...the joy of the Holy Spirit. (1 Thessalonians 1:6)
18. **Perseverance.** [Lord, grant us to] ...run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith,. (Hebrews 12:1-2a)
19. **Humility.** [God, teach us to clothe ourselves] ...with humility toward one another, for “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.” (1 Peter 5:5)
20. **Compassion.** [Lord, may we put on] ...as God’s chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,. (Colossians 3:12)
21. **Responsibility.** [Father, grant our children to learn responsibility,] For each one will have to bear his own load. (Galatians 6:5)
22. **Contentment.** [Lord, bring me to the point where I can say,] ...I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. (Philippians 4:11)
23. **Faith.** [I pray that my child will live a life of faith so that he will become] ...an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith. (Hebrews 11:7)
24. **Servant heart.** [Lord, grant to our children a servant] ...heart, rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man. (Ephesians 6:7)
25. **Hope.** May the God of hope fill [us] with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit [we] may abound in hope. (Romans 15:13)
26. **Willingness and ability to work.** [Teach our children to value work, for] In all toil there is profit, but mere talk tends only to poverty. (Proverbs 14:23)
27. **Passion for God.** [Father, create a hunger in our children that says], ...my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water. (Psalm 63:1)
28. **Self-discipline.** [Lord, help me walk] ...before the eyes of the LORD [and not be like the wicked who] is held fast in the cords of his sin [and] dies for lack of discipline. (Proverbs 5:21-23)
29. **Prayerfulness.** [Father, help parents model a life of prayerfulness so that their children will learn to pray] ...at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. (Ephesians 6:18)
30. **Gratitude.** [Father, may our children be so aware of you that they give] ...thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 5:20)
31. **Heart for missions.** [Lord, make us all eager to] Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples! (Psalm 96:3)
