Praying through Philippians-

1. **--thank God for one another praying with joy that we have (koinonia) fellowship in the gospel.** Php. 1:3-5 I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now.
2. **--praise God for His faithful work in us.** Php. 1:6 And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.
3. **--pray this for one another.** Php. 1:9-11 And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.
4. **--boldly, lovingly, sincerely proclaim Christ and the gospel.** Php. 1:14-17 And most of the brothers, having become confident in the Lord by my imprisonment, are much more bold to speak the word without fear. Some indeed preach Christ from envy and rivalry, but others from good will. The latter do it out of love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel. The former proclaim Christ out of rivalry, not sincerely but thinking to afflict me in my imprisonment.
5. **--REJOICE in the proclamation of Christ!** Php. 1:18 What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed, and in that I rejoice. Yes, and I will rejoice.
6. **--always honor Christ with our life.** Php. 1:20...as it is my eager expectation and hope that I will not be at all ashamed, but that with full courage now as always Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death.
7. **--may Christ be our all, always.** Php. 1:21 For me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.
8. **--as citizens of heaven, live our lives worthy of the gospel of Christ.** Php. 1:27 Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ...
9. **--receive suffering as a gift from God for the sake of Christ.** Php. 1:29 For it has been granted to you that for the sake of Christ you should not only believe in him but also suffer for his sake...
10. **--unite our hearts through the gospel.** Php. 2:1-2 So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind.
11. **--serve one another humbly as Christ served us.** Pray Php. 2:3-8
12. **--bow before the glorious name of Jesus, confessing his Lordship in our life.** Php. 2:9-10 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee would bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

13. **–live Coram Deo (before the face of God).** Php. 2:12-13 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.
14. **–mind our mouths.** Php. 2:14,15 Do all things without grumbling or questioning, that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world...
15. **–hold fast to the gospel.** Php 2:16...holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain.
16. **–receive and honor God’s workers.** Php. 2:29,30 So receive him in the Lord with all joy, and honor such men, for he nearly died for the work of Christ, risking his life to complete what was lacking in your service to me.
17. **–rejoice, Christians.** Php. 3:1 Finally, my brothers, rejoice in the Lord...
18. **–worship and glory in Christ.** Php. 3:3 For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh --
19. **–continual passion to know Christ.** Pray Php. 3:8-11
20. **–I live in the already, but not yet, please give me strength to progressively press on to the goal.** Pray Php. 3:12-16
21. **–O Lord, may we joyfully await our true home.** Php. 3:20,21 But our citizenship is in heaven and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.
22. **–do not waver.** Php. 4:1 Therefore, my brothers, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm thus in the Lord, my beloved.
23. **–Christians, don’t stop rejoicing in the Lord.** Php. 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always, again I will say, Rejoice.
24. **–forbear like Christ.** Php. 4:5 Let your reasonableness be known to everyone.
25. **–stop worrying and pray about everything with a thankful heart.** Php. 5b-7 The Lord is at hand; do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
26. **–mind our mind.** Php. 4:8 Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.
27. **–practice obedience and the God of peace will be with you.** Php. 4:9 What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me-practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.
28. **–learn to be content in Christ.** Php. 4:11 Not that I am speaking of being in need, for I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content.
29. **–depend on Christ always, in everything.** Php. 4:13 I can do all things through him who strengthens me.
30. **–thank you Lord for this beautiful promise.** Php. 4:19 And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
31. **–enable me everyday to live 2022 for your glory through the grace of my Lord Jesus Christ.** Php. 4:20, 23 To our God and Father be glory forever and ever. Amen...The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit.
