

## October 2022 Tulsa Bible Church Prayer Calendar

**In October, we remember the work of the Reformers. One of the key tenets of the Reformation was “sola fide” which means that we are saved by grace through “faith alone,” and not by works. As you are able, please join in fasting and prayer Saturday Oct 1<sup>st</sup> from 7AM to Noon.**

### **Week 1: Pray for someone each day that has not experienced the saving grace of Jesus Christ**

Oct 1 “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

Oct 2 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. Ephesians 2:8-9

Oct 3 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23

Oct 4 yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, Galatians 2:16a

Oct 5 Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent." John 6:29

Oct 6 And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." Acts 16:31

Oct 7 But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:12-13

### **Week 2: Pray for the Elders and Deacons of Tulsa Bible Church each day that they will lead through their trust and faith in God as they consider many spiritual and tangible needs of the church.**

Oct 8 “Be still and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!” Psalm 46:10

Oct 9 But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." Acts 6:4

Oct 10 ...appoint elders...if anyone is above reproach, the husband of one wife, and his children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination. Titus 1:5b,6

Oct 11 For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain, Titus 1:7

Oct 12 but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined. Titus 1:8

Oct 13 He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it. Titus 1:9

Oct 14 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting... James 1:5

### **Week 3: Pray daily for a specific missionary that Tulsa Bible Church supports to strengthen their faith as they share the gospel worldwide**

Oct 15 Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. 1Timothy 6:12

Oct 16 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance. Hebrews 11:8a

Oct 17 So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. James 2:17

Oct 18 Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? Matthew 6:30

Oct 19 Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. ... For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. 2 Corinthians 4:1, 5

Oct 20 Since we have the same spirit of faith according to what has been written, "I believed, and so I spoke," we also believe, and so we also speak, knowing that he who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and bring us with you into his presence. 2 Corinthians 4:13-14

Oct 21 For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:18

**Week 4: Pray daily for someone who is experiencing a sickness or injury that the Lord will heal them fully**

Oct 22 And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. James 5:15

Oct 23 And behold, some people brought to him a paralytic, lying on a bed. And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." Matthew 9:2

Oct 24 Then Jesus answered her, "O woman, great is your faith! Be it done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed instantly. Matthew 15:28

Oct 25 And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace, and be healed of your disease." Mark 5:34

Oct 26 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said, "I believe; help my unbelief!" Mark 9:24

Oct 27 And Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him on the way. Mark 10:52

Oct 28 Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me. 9 But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 2 Corinthians 12:8-9

**Week 5: Pray daily for a person in your extended family who is an unbeliever that they may come to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior.**

Oct 29 ...if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9

Oct 30 For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. - Romans 10:10

Oct 31 For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." ...So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ. Romans 10:13, 17

**And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him. -1John 5:14-15**
